Promoters Letter of Agreement

I, _____ will be the race promoter of the _____ race on ____/____/2010. By signing the agreement I agree to abide by the terms set forth by the Tour de Dirt (TdD). Below are the terms of this agreement.

PROMOTERS RESPONSIBILITIES

1. The promoter must pay a \$50.00 registration fee to join the TdD. This fee will be refunded if all the TdD and USAC requirements are met.
2. The promoter shall be responsible for specifying and directing the general aspects of the race and especially for meeting obligations imposed by the public authorities.
3. Each promoter shall agree to abide by and enforce the rules and regulations of USA Cycling and TdD as well as decisions made by officials in accordance with these regulations.
4. The promoter agrees to work with the assigned TdD Ambassador. The Ambassador will contact the promoter six weeks prior to the event. See TdD Rules and Regulations for more details.
5. Promoters will submit a flyer in electronic form 5 weeks prior to event date. So we can get it posted on the TdD website 4 weeks prior to the event.
6. Promoters shall agree that the safety of participants and spectators is an essential consideration in organizing a cycling competition and they shall take those reasonable acts necessary to promote the safety of participants and spectators.
7. Promoters shall require a written entry form from each race entrant. The entry form must be hand-signed before the start of the race by the entrant and the parent or legal guardian of any minor entrant, and it must include the terms of the Standard Athlete's Entry Blank and Release Form as published by USA Cycling. The promoter shall keep the forms for ten years, available for use by USA Cycling or in any legal proceedings. This form is available online at USA Cycling's website.
8. The promoter is responsible for paying the race officials on the day of the race immediately after the race results are final, upon receipt of an invoice from the chief referee. A check for the insurance surcharge shall be made out to "USA Cycling" and sent by the organizer, along with the post-event report, to USA Cycling no later than 21 days after the event. The promoter must pay the TdD \$2.00 surcharge collected from each competitor immediately after the race results are final, upon receipt of an invoice from the Crunch Production Representative.
9. All events on the TdD Series must comply to the rules of the TdD or risk being disqualified from the TdD Series.
10. All events on the TdD must be USA Cycling sanctioned.
11. A copy of the guidelines and rules should be kept at registration to be made available if needed.
12. Competitor start times are to be posted in plain sight at all times while registration is open.

13. The course must be marked one weekend prior to event for pre-riding (For example ribbons on left side of trail).

14. It will be the responsibility of the promoter to see that the course is well marked and safe on day of event.

15. Leg Marking will be used to help competitors identify each other when out on course.

16. Results board must be used at all events. This should be located near the finish area.

17. A neutral feed zone must be offered for all multi-lap events. Water will be provided by promoter. (Required by USA Cycling)

18. Top 5 TdD Series leaders must line up on the front row, called up at staging.

19. The promoter will be responsible for displaying any TdD banners and media in and around the registration area.

20. At a minimum 2 bathroom facilities must be available near staging area.

21. CAT 1 Payout schedule (% pay out) is to be posted in plain sight at all times while registration is open. (If listed on flier, you got it covered)

22. Results must be sent in to TdD with in 7 days following your event. Results must be submitted in the same excel format as USA Cycling and emailed to the TdD Director.

23. Results should contain:

- Racers name
- USA Cycling number
- TdD Race Number
- Finish position
- Class and Category
- Time
- Race team (if provided)

24. All results should be sent to the TdD Director: Andy Harris okracex@gmail.com

25. All other USA Cycling rules apply if a subject is not covered in this document. You are encouraged, as a promoter, to read the USA Cycling Rule Book and have a copy available during your event.

26. All checks to the Tour de Dirt must made payable to CRUNCH Productions.
